



SYC Water Sports Reservation and Guest Policy

SYC Membership:

1. An SYC Member Family comprises a husband and wife (or legal significant other) and their children under the age of 22.
2. A single SYC Member may bring a companion, who is not counted toward the guest limitation.
3. Adult Children, 22 and older, are not members and will be considered as guests.
4. Grandchildren are not members and will be considered as guests.

A Member Family may bring two guests (or four guests, when equipment is not being used or reserved.) A member must accompany guests to the pier when the equipment is checked out.

Reservations may be made as long as a week in advance by phoning 831-625-2480 or by visiting the Boathouse. The hours of operation are 11:00 to 5:00, Mon thru Wed, and 11:00 to 7:00, Thurs thru Sunday. Sailboats must be returned by 30 minutes before closing time and kayaks / paddleboards by 15 minutes before closing time:

- During Youth Water Sports program hours (1:00-4:30 M-F for 8 wks), instructors have priority for equipment.
- A kayak or paddleboard reservation may be for as long as two hours and a keelboat (Santana or Catalina) reservation may be for as long as four hours.
- One person on each Santana or Catalina must have Basic Keelboat Sailing Certification (ASA.)
- One person on each Pico or FJ must meet the Basic Small Boat Sailing Standard (ASA 110), judged by one of our sailing instructors or Harbormasters.
- A reservation can include a request for more than one single kayak, but on busy days the Harbormaster may issue a double-seated kayak rather than two singles.

A reservation is forfeited when member is over 15 minutes late. Then it is first come, first served.

Each year, before using SYC equipment, each member and guest, 18 or older, must sign a Waiver of Liability. For participants under the age of 18, his/her parent or legal guardian must sign the Waiver of Liability.

Equipment is not to be beached. Kayaks and Paddleboards are not to be used beyond an unmarked boundary stretching from the 7th green to the long house at Cypress Point. Any damage caused by beaching the equipment or taking the equipment beyond the boundary is the responsibility of the member.

While using an SYC boat/kayak/board, each person must wear a USCG approved personal flotation device. SYC and Pebble Beach Company assume no responsibility for performing any rescue or assistance to any person using an SYC boat/kayak/board.
